



Frequently asked questions

What are the English language requirements for the scholarships?

You should note that the English language requirements for some scholarships are higher than the standard requirement for admission to the University and that some Schools require a higher level of English than the standard admission requirement.

HOME/EU APPLICANTS

Applicants whose first language is not English must meet the University's English Language requirements. You should have a valid test result, which is normally no more than two years old by your official start date at the University of Leeds. INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

Applicants whose first language is not English must have **already met** the University's English Language requirements by the **closing date of the particular scholarship**. You should have a valid test result, which is normally no more than two years old by your official start date at the University of Leeds. My first language is not English and I will not receive my IELTS/TOEFL test result until after the closing date of the scholarship. Can I still apply?

HOME/EU APPLICANTS

Yes, you can apply for the scholarship. If you have an English language condition stipulated in your study offer letter it is strongly recommended that you take the relevant English language test at the earliest opportunity.

INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

As international students have to have already met the English language qualification by the relevant scholarship deadline, and you have to confirm that you have a valid test result on the online application form, you should only submit a scholarship application form after you have received the required English language test result, but before the scholarship deadline.

What are the English language requirements for admission to the University of Leeds?

All students whose first language is not English are required to provide satisfactory evidence of a recognised English language qualification prior to registration:
